The Finance and Planning Committee report was given this evening by Mr. Kenney.

## The Committee will consider the following actions this evening:

- Consideration that APRIL 2012 invoices in the amount of \$739,834.89 be paid as follows: General (\$276,234.98); Street Lights (\$2,034.79); Fire (\$58,176.57); Parks & Rec. (\$16,783.20); Water (\$117,624.21); Sewer (\$118,497.79); WWTP (\$160,808.63); Rail Corridor (\$0.00); Road Overlay (\$0.00); Debt Fund (\$0.00); Water Capital (\$0.00); Liquid Fuels (\$2,165.51) with voided checks totaling \$12,490.79.
- 2. The Committee will consider a recommendation to award a feasibility study for the Lindenwold lot/parking deck based upon quotes obtained from the Harmon Group and Tim Haas Engineers.

Discussion ensued. Ms. Tomlinson stated she did not feel as though she was comparing cost quotes for comparable scopes of work and stated her concern about the potential for run-away costs for reimbursable expenses. Mr. S. Pasceri also stated his concern about reimbursable expenses. Jim Dougherty, Borough Engineer, stated that the Borough would not necessarily have to contract with the same engineering firm for the feasibility study and for the preliminary design phase of the project. He recommended awarding to Harmon Group which provided the lowest quote, even though reimbursable expenses were open-ended. Mr. Kenney suggested a cap on reimbursable expenses not to exceed \$500.00.

- 3. General Code is completing final additional updates to the Code of Ordinances and will be preparing an Ordinance Adopting the Revised Code of Ordinances. Authorization is requested to advertise the Ordinance for adoption.
- 4. A request was received to adopt an emergency resolution to save our economy in support of the Glass-Steagall Act, National Banking and NAWAPA.

Mr. Kenney stated the Committee would table discussion on this request. A brief discussion, however, ensued wherein Mr. Kenney pointed out that this was a request from LaRouchePAC. Mr. Kenney stated he was not interested in aligning with a PAC and that he would prefer removing this item from any future Committee agenda. The Committee agreed.
