MINUTES AMBLER BOROUGH PLANNING COMMISSION

August 16, 2010

The Ambler Borough Planning Commission held a *Special Meeting* on Monday, August 16, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. in Borough Council Chambers located at 122 East Butler Avenue, Ambler, Pennsylvania. Chairman Ware presided.

The purpose of the meeting was to review site building elevations for a new two-story commercial building located at 30 S. Bethlehem Pike which is to have three small apartments on the second floor.
