**You are reminded that State law prohibits disposal of TVs and computers with your trash. Your trash hauler will not take these items. You are responsible for the safe and legal disposal of E-waste.**

**Ambler Borough has coordinated with Upper Dublin Township** to offer you the opportunity to responsibly recycle obsolete electronics on Saturday, May 14, 2016. This service is available to all residents and small businesses with fewer than 50 employees. Ambler Borough residents are encouraged to participate. Proof of residency will be required. Please be aware that Montgomery County will not be holding an E-waste collection event in 2016. **This is your opportunity to dispose of those electronics you no longer need!** Electronics will be recycled by eForce Compliance, Philadelphia's first Certified Responsible Recycler. eForce Compliance will accept all electronic devices with a plug. **NO SMOKE DETECTORS, LARGE APPLIANCES or PROJECTION TVs will be accepted.**

**All Data Media Will Be Destroyed or Wiped!**

**\$20 fee per TV or Computer Monitor**

**\$10 fee per Microwave, Dehumidifier, Air Conditioner**
