2. Please see the following request from the Tax Collector: The certification charge is \$15 for the current year and \$10 for each additional year. The request is to increase the charge to \$25 for the current year, keeping the additional years at \$10. The Committee meeting was held on January 7 at 7:00pm. Committee members: Amy Hughes – Chair, Jen Henderson, Nancy Roecker Coates and Lou Orehek. Absent - Mayor Sorg and Chief Borkowski.

The Committee will consider the following recommendation.

1. The Police Department would like to purchase a Ford Interceptor at a cost of \$44,200, attached. There is a separate charge for the vehicle's upfitting of \$18,714.38. Total cost does not exceed \$65K for vehicle and upfitting. This was approved in the 2025 budget.
