ORDINANCE 1091

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF AMBLER PERMITTING THE WALKING OF LEASHED DOGS IN AMBLER BOROUGH PARK; REQUIRING WASTE PICKUP; CONTINUING THE PROHIBITION OF DOGS IN THE OTHER PARKS IN THE BOROUGH; EFFECTIVE UPON ADOPTION

Having concluded that it is in the best interests of the citizens and consistent with the safety, health and welfare of the Borough, Borough Council has decided to allow the walking of leashed dogs in Ambler Borough Park, and in furtherance thereof, ORDAINS as follows:

Ordinance 1034 as codified in the Borough Codified Ordinances at 16-102(K) is amended by the addition of the following language:

Notwithstanding such prohibition, dogs may be walked in Borough Park provided that: they are kept on a leash at all times; the person walking the dog shall immediately pick up the dog's waste and dispose of it properly; and, dogs with a known propensity to act viciously towards people or other dogs are not permitted to be walked in the park.

The remainder of the Ordinance remains in full force and effect, unaffected by this amendment.
