We will be set up at the **Calvary United Methodist Church**, 16 E Park Avenue, Ambler and are accepting electronics for recycling. Bring all of your old, broken, or unwanted electronics! If it has a plug, battery, or charger we can recycle it and keep it out of the landfill! You do not need to be resident to participate!

If It Plugs In ABR Can Recycle It! Most electronics can be recycled for free including:

Computers, Laptops, Tablets, and Accessories; Keyboards, Mice, Printers and Speakers; Flat Screen LED/LCD TVs and Monitors; Cell Phones, Office Phones, and Home Telephones; Cameras, Remotes, Routers, Modems; Stereo Equipment, Record Players, Speakers, etc.; DVD Players, Blu-Ray Players, and VCRs; Video Game Consoles, Controllers and Accessories; Microwaves, Blenders, & other Household Electronics; Air Conditioners, Dehumidifiers, Mini Fridges; Cords, Cables, Chargers, etc.

We Can Keep it Out of the Landfill!

Items with recycling fees are listed below:

CRT Tube Televisions and Monitors

Under 22": \$30 fee 22" – 27': \$50 fee 27" – 32": \$100 fee

Plasma TVs (52" or Smaller) - \$50 fee

Items Not Accepted: Sorry, we can't take them at this event. Please email for more information.

CRT tube TVs over 32" or wooden cabinet (console) TVs Plasma TVs over 52" Projection, DLP, and Floor model TVs Large appliances (Refrigerator, Stoves, Dishwashers etc...) Light bulbs
