Journeywork: Check their website (www.Journeywork.org) for signing up for their program called “Pollinator Palooza”. Get a set of 28 native sun plants for \$75 and/or a set of 28 native dry shade plants for \$75 or multiples. Sign up during spring registration April 1 to May 15 and then get them in the fall or fall registration September 1 to October 27, 2026 and get them next Spring. Volunteers from Journeywork help to install your garden at your house. Free guides available. Journeywork is local at Gwynedd Friends Meeting House and is a 501©3 organization that also provides training classes and information on planting these plants. Journeywork also lists native plant sources and support elements on their website.
